Voucher Program = \$\$ Reimburse 50% up to \$500 <u>Site visit required</u>

- \$ Glasses, gloves & N95 masks
- \$ Storage containers
- \$ 3-Free Nail polish
- \$ Local exhaust ventilation



3-Free Polish =
No Formaldehyde,
Toluene or
dibutyl phthalate









Chemicals of concern





- Acrylic nails
 - asthma, skin, throat...
- Nail polish
 - Dibutyl phthalate (endocrine disruptor)
 - Formaldehyde (carcinogen)
 - Toluene (carcinogen)
- Nail polish removers
 - Toluene, acetone, xylene, MEK (headaches)



Poor chemical storage & hygiene

- No lids on chemicals
- Waste containers left open
- Confused about sanitation/disinfection
- Poor ventilation
- Not aware of fire hazards







Nail spa for kids?

Kids in the salon

- Consider the risks
 - Infections
 - Chemical exposure
- Ask for 3-Free polishes
- Don't go if
 - Strong smell
 - Dirty
 - Can't answer how they clean the footspa





Effects of size on response

How to find a safer salon





Is your favorite spa clean?





Tech should clean & disinfect



Ask clients to wash hands before & after treatment

- 1. Wash hands before & after customers.
- 2. Clean towel for each customer
- Wash client treatment areas with hospital-grade disinfectant (10% bleach).







Don't let tech re-use tools on you!

Must throw away non-metal tools after each customer

- ➤ Nail files
- ➤ Buffers
- > Buffing discs on electric files
- ➤ Wood cuticle sticks
- > Toe separators (use paper separators)

Save money by cutting buffers in ½.

- Licensing Inspection Form
- Footspa Whirlpool Cleaning Log
- Photo ID on nail tech license
- Business License





Ask for healthier treatments



Toluene-formaldehyde-dibutyl pthalate, MEK free polishes

Choose treatment # 1 or 2 to be safer:

- 1. Manicure with nail polish using 3-free polish
- 2. Manicure with gel hybrid polish (sun-cured top coat)
- 3. Manicure with gel polish (UV lamp cured)
- 4. Manicure with hard gels (UV lamp cured)
- 5. Manicure with acrylics (chemical reaction cured)



Healthy Nail Salon Recognition Program

Goal: To create a safe work place for King County nail salon technicians by rewarding nail salon businesses who safely handle, store and dispose of salon chemicals, improve ventilation and use safer chemicals.
